Immunization Awareness Camp -

There was a growing misunderstanding and fear about the Corona disease and also about vaccination against Covid among people in remote areas.



A government vaccination campaign was launched, but people did not respond due to increasing prevalence and growing misconceptions.

We made informative videos and audios and sent them by phone wherever possible to dispel the rumors about vaccinations. Our team went from village to village in the Bhamragad area to make people aware of vaccination by playing audio in vehicle. People responded more positively to vaccination as a result.

Here, the second wave of Covid-19 is more prevalent. The hospital had to be very careful when admitting patients with covid-19 due to the onset of other illnesses also. In particular, pregnant women are admitted before the expected delivery date. On 13th May we started testing not only indoor but also outdoor patients before admission.

Immunization at your doorstep-

Due to Bhamragad's remote location, it was a little difficult for people to come for vaccinations, and many things contributed to this, such as the misunderstanding of the local people. The community hospital started vaccinating people using the trust they've established. The taluka health system made it easier to do so.



Priority was given to vaccination in the villages which were cut off during the monsoon season. One had to visit the village a day in advance and hold a Gramsabha. As vaccinations became more difficult during this period, the work of cutting the bidipatta of the tribal people began. Vaccinations were accelerated by the community's participation. Misunderstandings between villages diminished. Surrounding villages were motivated to get vaccinated by each other.

The hospital team vaccinated 30 villages and vaccinated 1062 people. We traveled to more than 30 villages to do vaccinations. The hospital used to go to the village with a team of doctors, nurses, and other staff members for vaccination.
